

Use of Specialist Contractors

What safety management responsibilities apply

Specialist Contractor (them)

- Establish with the client, the specific work to be performed and resources required
- Activate hazard management processes and controls specific to the job requirements and setting (e.g. customised Safe Work Method Statement or Job Safety Analysis)
- Provide evidence of insurance, relevant qualifications, licenses, certifications relevant to the work
- Perform the specialised work on the client's premises in line with the scope of engagement
- Ensure people employed/engaged by the contractor are qualified, skilled and experienced to perform the work safely and to a quality standard
- Comply with onsite safety requirements

Host (you)

- Check that **all the above** has been done
- Induct the contractor and their team, to the worksite and the relevant work areas
- Explain known safety hazards that may affect them while onsite
- Provide adequate supervision of the contractors to ensure their safety and safety of others
- Act on safety queries and concerns raised
